## **Short-Film**

The art of storytelling in a condensed format – short films are a thrilling way to convey complex ideas, emotions, and narratives. In this category, participants will push the boundaries of cinematic storytelling, experimenting with visuals, sound, and editing to craft compelling tales that leave a lasting impact. Prepare to be entertained, inspired, and moved!

#### **Video Specifications:**

- Format: Short-form video (TikTok/Instagram Reels style)
- Duration: 30 seconds 3 minutes (maximum)
- Orientation: Vertical (preferred), but horizontal accepted
- Language: English or Urdu (subtitles encouraged if possible)
- Style: Can be dramatized, animated, spoken word, art-based, or documentary style
- Originality: Content must be original (no copyrighted music, clips, or text unless royalty-free)

#### Files should be named as follows:

"Full name\_Category\_Institute\_2025", and then upload it on google drive. Paste its link in Google Form and give access as "anyone with the link"

### Judgment Criteria.

- Entries for Angan will be evaluated by a panel of experienced judges, esteemed in their respective artistic fields.
- Submissions will be assessed based on several key criteria, including originality, creativity, technical skill, adherence to the chosen category's theme, and message clarity.
- The judges' decision will be final and binding, ensuring a fair and comprehensive review process for all participants.

### Eligibility.

Category 1: O-Level & A-Level students (13–18 years)
Category 2: University & Medical Students (Undergraduate,
Graduate, Postgraduate up to age 30)

### Rules and SOPs

All submissions must respect confidentiality, dignity, and sensitivity regarding mental health.

- No content that is derogatory, triggering (graphic self-harm, suicide depiction, etc.), discriminatory, or promotes harmful stereotypes.
- Participants are encouraged to share hopeful and empowering messages.
- By submitting, participants grant permission for their videos to be showcased during the conference and on official social media platforms (with credit).

## Prizes and recognition

Top 3 winners in each category will receive:

- Certificates of Achievement
- Prizes (cash prizes, vouchers, or conference-sponsored gifts)
- Winning videos showcased at the conference & official pages
- All participants receive Certificates of Participation

Videos will be displayed on 28th November on the day of conference and awards will be announced on the same day
